

INFORMATION ON THE SECURITY OF GAS SYSTEMS

Water heaters and gas boilers if used wrongly can cause a health hazard and.

Also be a risk to life.

Carbon monoxide can escape from the gas systems, it is poisonous and dangerous

As it does not smell.

TO AVOID BEING INTOXICATED JUST FOLLOW SOME SIMPLE RULES:

1. In the rooms where the gas boiler is situated there must be a ventilation opening towards the open air of adequate dimensions. Never close it.
2. The heater and gas boiler must be linked to the smoke conductor safely, otherwise it should never be turned on.
3. If the apparatus goes off frequently something is wrong. Call immediately a specialized technician and do not touch the system.
4. It is important that every year the systems are controlled by only specialised technicians.
